Saint John Fire Service Differential Response DMAIC



Problem Statement

Five apparatuses and twenty firefighters are available for deployment from five fire stations located throughout Saint John each shift. Firefighters and apparatuses were being deployed to calls where Fire presence is not required. In 2016, there were 583 responses to automated fire alarms. Ninety-nine percent of the alarm calls were for false alarms. There were also 640 responses to EMS calls where no services were required by the Fire Service.
